**ACT Student Champion Scholarship:** ACT Student Champions receive a \$500 non-renewable scholarship, certificate, and state-level recognition.

You should meet the following criteria:

High school seniors who have overcome challenges and can articulate their education and/or career actions. At a minimum, students must have a composite ACT score of 22 on a single test date OR a Gold ACT® WorkKeys® National Career Readiness Certificate® Applications can be found

The deadline for applications is **November 15, 2018** and applications can be found at **The Herb Kohl Foundation Scholarships**: The foundation awards \$10,000 scholarships to 100 Wisconsin high school graduates each year.

Who Is Eligible to Apply?

Applicants must be graduating high school students who intend to enroll in a postsecondary institution, which may be a public or nonpublic university, college, or vocational/technical college. Students who are residents of the State of Wisconsin, are in good standing, and who demonstrate probable success in postsecondary education are eligible to apply. This is a competitive scholarship.

Eligibility is not limited by GPA, class rank, or any other school or program conferred status (ex. National Honor Society). Any student who meets the above eligibility criteria may apply.

**Elks National Foundation Most Valuable Student**: The Elks National Foundation will award 500 four-year scholarships to the highest-rated applicants in the 2019 competition.

Most Valuable Student scholarships are for students pursuing a four-year degree, on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 semester hours), in a U.S. college or university. All scholarships are in the form of certificates of award conditional upon the <https://www.elks.org/scholars/scholarships/mvs.cfm>.

**Bluemke Science, Technology, Engineering & Mathematics Scholarship**: One graduating Nathan High School Senior will be selected for this 4-Year\* Full-Tuition Award.

Eligibility Requirements: The student must enroll in a 4-year University of Wisconsin campus and elect a Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics Major which will lead to a Bachelor of Science (B.S.) Degree in 4 years (\*up to 5 years for an Engineering Major), providing a cumulative 3.0 GPA is maintained.
