**Dress for Winter Weather** Adults and children should wear:

- a hat
- a scarf or knit mask to cover face and mouth
- sleeves that are snug at the wrist
- mittens (they are warmer than gloves)
- water-resistant coat and shoes
- several layers of loose-fitting clothing

Be sure the outer layer of your clothing is tightly woven, preferably wind resistant, to reduce body-heat loss caused by wind. Wool, silk, or polypropylene inner layers of clothing will hold more body heat than cotton. Stay dry—wet clothing chills the body rapidly. Excess perspiration will increase heat loss, so remove extra layers of clothing whenever you feel too warm. Also, avoid getting gasoline or alcohol on your skin while deicing and fueling your car or using a snow blower. These materials in contact with the skin greatly increase heat loss from the body. Do not ignore shivering. It's an important first sign that the body is losing heat. Persistent shivering is a signal to return indoors.

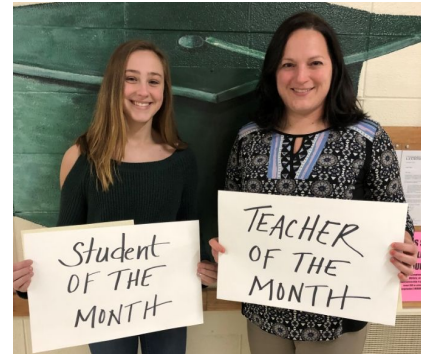

**Blumke Science, Technology, Engineering, & Mathematics Scholarship** Description: One graduating NHHS Senior will be selected for this 4-Year\* Full-Tuition Award.

**Eligibility Requirements:** The student must enroll in a 4-year University of Wisconsin campus and elect a Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics Major which will lead to a Bachelor of Science (B.S.) Degree in 4 years (\*up to 5 years for an Engineering Major), providing a cumulative 3.0 GPA is maintained.

**West Allis-West Milwaukee Monogram Club Scholarship** Description: The West Allis/West Milwaukee Monogram Organization annually awards scholarships to student athletes who attend either Central or Nathan Hale High Schools for use in the student's first year of college. Those students who will be graduating in June of 2019 and who attend a college, university, or technical school in the fall of 2019 are eligible to receive a scholarship. The number of scholarships awarded each year is determined by the Organization each spring just prior to the selection process. Therefore, the Organization cannot, at this time, state the number of scholarships that will be awarded. **This past year, the Organization awarded twelve \$1,000 scholarships.**

**AB Nicholas Scholarship** This year the Ab Nicholas Scholarship Foundation will offer scholarships to approximately 65 Wisconsin public and private high school graduates based on need, academic achievement and character. **The annual scholarships--\$10,000 for four-year programs and \$5,000 for two-year programs-are renewable** for the length of the program.

**Athletic Requirements:** You must be participating in your high school's boys or girls basketball program during this (your senior) year either as a player or a manager.

**Financial Requirements:** The foundation uses your completed Free Application For Student Aid form (FAFSA) to determine financial need.

You may also apply for and receive other financial aid.

**Educational Requirements:** You must be a 2018 graduating senior of a Wisconsin high school – public or private. You must attend a University of Wisconsin System school as a full-time student (at least 12 credits), enrolled in a 2-year or 4-year program. To renew your scholarship, you must maintain performance consistent with the original award criteria, including a cumulative grade point average greater than 2.0.

**Other Requirements:**

You must be a bona fide resident of Wisconsin. You will need a unique student ID number for the UW System school(s) you are applying to. You will need a completed FAFSA form on file (Free Application For Student Aid) for your application to be considered. You will need to file an application online during the enrollment period of **February 1 – April 30 of your senior year.**
