Juniors-ACT Practice Test:

As a reminder, this **Wednesday, October 9th, we will be conducting the ACT practice test for all Juniors.** This is a mandatory day of attendance. You will receive your testing ticket in homeroom advisory tomorrow and you should bring this along Wednesday morning, as well as #2 pencils, eraser, and a calculator (graphing or scientific) to the main gym at 7:45 for testing. Testing ends at about 12:15 p.m. followed by a pizza lunch provided by the school with Juniors back for part of 6th hour. As was discussed at the Junior Class meeting, the scores achieved on this assessment will not affect any class grade, but will give you valuable information as all of our juniors prepare to take the official state ACT test as a school later this year on March 3.
