THINGS TO KNOW

1. This Thursday and Friday, students will not be able to use the ramp hallway going from the back of the building by Tech Ed to the front of the building by the cafeteria as there will be maintenance work going on with a need to block it off. Those with crutch or wheelchair accessibility will be through using the lift in the commons.
2. Hale-issued locks - they must have a green face. Please remove any locks that are not purchased through Hale, any locks that are not Hale locks, will be removed. Hale locks are sold before school and after school in the main office.
