Student Bulletin: Tomorrow we are distributing the End-of-Year student bulletin with all important exam week information regarding such items as Exam Exemptions, Exam Schedule, Book Return, Detention Completion, and Senior reminders.

Exam Exemption Distribution: Exam exemption distribution day is tomorrow, Wednesday, May 29th. Junior and Senior Exam exemption certificates will be distributed in Homeroom, while 9th and 10th grade English and math teachers will distribute theirs to students in class.

Homeroom Survey: Today in Homeroom everyone should be completing the one question survey related to our "relationship" goal. One of our goals for Nathan Hale every year is that by June, 90% of the students will be able to identify at least one adult they feel is an advocate for them and they have a positive relationship with to get help, advice, or share a concern. Today is the day we collect that info by marking "yes or no" and then adding the name of the staff you connect with on the survey.

Panorama Survey - Every student in our district is required to take the Panorama survey. The last two weeks we have designated homeroom time for this to occur; however, we still only have 70% of Hale students that have completed it. Panorama survey data is needed for our year-end school data, so it's important we complete this today in homeroom.
